Terms & Conditions of Entry & Indemnity Agreement

By entering and paying the entry fee for any event in the South Coast Adrenaline Series (“the Event”), including but not limited to the kayak race, mountain bike race, trail run, volley ball tournament, and obstacle course race, you (“the Participant”) acknowledge that you have read, understood, and agree to the following terms and conditions:

1. Assumption of Risk

1.1 Participation in the Event involves inherent risks, including but not limited to risks of personal injury, illness, permanent disability, or death, as well as damage to or loss of property.

1.2 The Participant acknowledges that these risks may arise from their own actions, the actions of others, the conditions of the Event, weather, water, terrain, equipment, or other factors beyond the control of the organisers.

1.3 By entering, the Participant voluntarily assumes all such risks.

2. Medical Fitness

2.1 The Participant warrants that they are physically fit, in good health, and capable of safely participating in the Event.

2.2 The Participant accepts responsibility for obtaining any necessary medical advice prior to participation.

2.3 The Participant consents to receive medical treatment which may be deemed necessary in the event of illness, injury, or accident during the Event, and agrees to be responsible for all associated costs.

3. Entry Conditions

3.1 Entry fees are payable in full upon registration and are non-refundable, except in the case of Event cancellation by the organisers.

3.2 Entries are non-transferable unless expressly permitted in writing by the organisers.

3.3 Participants must comply with all Event rules, instructions, signage, and directions given by officials, marshals, and medical staff.

3.4 The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry, disqualify, or remove any Participant who breaches these terms or whose conduct is deemed unsafe or unsporting.

4. Indemnity & Liability

4.1 The Participant releases, waives, and discharges the organisers, sponsors, landowners, volunteers, officials, affiliates, and representatives (“the Indemnified Parties”) from any and all liability, claims, demands, actions, or causes of action arising from participation in the Event, including negligence of the Indemnified Parties.

4.2 The Participant indemnifies and holds harmless the Indemnified Parties against all claims, damages, costs, or expenses (including legal costs) which may arise from:

- Their participation in the Event;
- Any breach of these terms;
- Any third-party claims caused by their actions or negligence.

4.3 Nothing in this agreement limits or excludes liability which cannot be excluded under South African law, including liability for death or personal injury caused by gross negligence.

5. Safety & Equipment

5.1 The Participant is responsible for ensuring they have suitable and safe equipment, clothing, and protective gear appropriate for the Event.

5.2 The organisers may inspect equipment and refuse participation if it is unsafe or inappropriate.

5.3 The Participant must comply with all safety instructions before, during, and after the Event.

6. Personal Belongings

6.1 The organisers will not be responsible for loss, theft, or damage to any personal property.

6.2 Storage or equipment stands may be provided but is used at the Participant’s own risk.

7. Use of Images or Footage

7.1 The Participant grants the organisers the right to use photographs, video, or other recordings of their participation for promotional, marketing, or reporting purposes without compensation.

7.2 All intellectual property rights in such materials remain the property of the organisers.

8. Event Changes & Cancellation

8.1 The organisers reserve the right to change the route, format, schedule, or any other aspect of the Event for safety, legal, or operational reasons.

8.2 The Event may be cancelled, delayed, or rescheduled due to weather, natural disasters, safety concerns, or circumstances beyond the organisers' control.

8.3 In the event of cancellation, the organisers' liability is limited to a refund or credit of the entry fee (at their discretion).

9. Legal Jurisdiction

9.1 These terms are governed by the laws of the Republic of South Africa.

9.2 Any disputes will be subject to the jurisdiction of the courts of South Africa.

10. Acknowledgement

By completing the registration and payment process, the Participant acknowledges that they have read, understood, and agree to be bound by these Terms & Conditions and the Indemnity Agreement.

10.1 In the event that any provision of this Agreement is held to be invalid or unenforceable, the parties agree that such invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision of this Agreement, and the remaining provisions shall continue in full force and effect.

10.2 By completing the registration and payment process, the Participant acknowledges that they have read, understood, and agree to be bound by these Terms & Conditions and the Indemnity Agreement.
